

## **Keep Your Pet Healthy**

**Understand what the most common poisons are to your pet**. Knowing common poisons helps you stay mindful of what's around your pet and what to remove from their reach.

## The top poisons for pets include:

- Over the counter and prescription medications
- Grapes
- Raisins
- Chocolate
- Onions
- Pennies
- Lilies
- Sago palms
- Azaleas
- Rhododendrons
- Daffodils

**Learn the signs of poisoning.** Common symptoms your pet may show include:

- Drooling
- Vomiting
- · Loss of appetite
- Diarrhea
- Lethargy, weakness
- · Pale or yellowish gums
- Coughing of blood
- Excessive thirst or urination

**Seek help right away.** If you suspect your pet is experiencing poisoning, contact your veterinarian or emergency veterinarian if after hours. You can also call the pet poison hotline at 1-800-213-6680.
